The massive impact of the ongoing Corona crisis underlines the importance of Global Health. There is an urgent need to develop evidence-based policies that protect the health, economical and social situations of even the most vulnerable populations. It is particularly important to understand how the Global North and the Global South differ in terms of health perspectives that significantly impact their health governance and the nature of international agreements and cooperation.

In our CAS on Research Concepts and Methods you can learn how to measure and analyse health, disease, risk factors, economic issues, health services and social phenomenon. We train professionals in epidemiology, statistics, qualitative research methods, and teach them the key concepts of Global Urban health, health governance and health systems. This CAS also includes an exciting excursion to Geneva where we visit leading international health organisations like the World Health Organisation (WHO) and United Nations Development Programme (UNDP). This CAS is part of the MSc Global Urban Health program. All courses are in English.

Target Group: Health professionals, social scientists, researchers, and policy makers involved in health policy development and health intervention planning.
